Our mission at Sea40 is to provide an outlet for local (acoustic) performers to be heard. We encourage all levels of performers to hone their performance skills and talents in front of an audience. We ask that you keep your songs free of profanity or sexual vulgarity as our restaurant is open to the public.

1. Performances are 7:00 PM- 10:00 PM.

2. Sign-up time is 6:45PM First come – first served. PLEASE WRITE CLEARLY. Come on time to assure a time-slot.

3. Performers play 3 songs or 15 minutes total.

4. We provide: 2-microphones, 2 instrument cables, mic stands, and the house sound system. Other than that... bring what you need.

5. When you are next – please be ready. Your instruments should already be out of their cases and tuned-up. Be ready to take the stage when you are called.

6. Tune-up BEFORE you go on stage. If you have difficulty tuning, don't be embarrassed to ask someone for help. We're all friends here and we want you to sound good. Don't lose performance time playing the tune up song. 7. Perform material that you are comfortable with. We don't expect perfection but it's always best to be as prepared as you can be. Choose songs you are comfortable with.

8. BE CONSIDERATE OF THE OTHER PERFORMERS. Please be quiet and show respect for the performers on stage.

Do not play instruments while performers are on stage. APPLAUD FOR EVERYONE.

9. Please stay for the performers after yourself. We all like to have an audience and it's all about supporting one another.

10. We offer opportunities for Individual Paid Gigs to those who participate on our Open Mic Events!

Please Note:

No drum kits. Hand drums are acceptable.

Do Not Bring Amplifiers
